COMMENTS: The property files were overall maintained well. There were two issues noted in the following household files:

- Unit 1-1013: The rental rate of \$585 was listed on the lease contract which exceeds the maximum rent amount by \$2.00. On the day of the onsite visit, the reviewer requested a tenant ledger to see actual rental rate paid. The tenant ledger supports the resident only pays \$583 a month. Management was instructed to correct the lease amount on the lease. Prior to the issuance of this report, management provided TSAHC with a revised lease listing the correct rental rate.
- Unit 2-0305: The application in the file indicates that a household member may own real estate yet there was not verification or clarification of the real estate. Prior to the issuance of this repot, management provided TSAHC with supporting documentation that supports the tenant lived with her sister who owns the real estate.

All issues were cleared prior to the issuance of this report so no findings or observation were issued.
