COMMENTS: Overall, the tenant files are maintained in a neat and organized manner. There were a few issues noted (see below) however all corrections were submitted prior to the issuance of this review. No further action is required.

- <u>Under \$5,000 Asset Certificate form</u>: Question 4 at the bottom of the page was not selected for households that did not have assets. This was noted in the tenant files for 926 and 6534.
- <u>Child Support/Alimony Certification</u>: Section 4 indicting whether a household is or it not receiving support was not selected for units 2350, 5206, and 6501.
- Annual Eligibility Certification (AEC) form: The student status section of the AEC form was not completed for unit 6530.
- Unit Status Report (USR): The move-in date for unit 5233 was incorrect on the USR.
